9 a.m. to 12 noon – Cooking
Noon – Serving to public begins
12:30 p.m. – Judging begins
3 p.m. – Winners announced

Rules:

1. Each team will be provided an 8x8-foot plot on which to set up its booth, table, cookware, stove, chairs and sunshade. Teams must provide their own safe fuel and a fire extinguisher.
2. Except for soaking beans, all preparation should be done at the booth from 9 until noon.
3. Each team must prepare a minimum of 3 gallons of chili. Two gallons will be for sampling by the public, one-half gallon for the judges and the remainder in case of a tie. After 3 p.m., chili can be sold to the public but free sampling must continue to be provided.
4. Each team must provide 2 oz. of chili for each ticket provided by a sampling member of the public. Little Brown Church will provide the \$5 sampling kits, which will include 5 cups, 5 spoons, a paper napkin and a ballot for voting for the People's Choice.
5. Chili contestants can offer such accompaniments as crackers and corn chips with their samples.
6. Chili is defined as a combination of spices and other ingredients, including red chilis. Beans or pasta can be included. Vegetarian entries must contain no meat or meat products.
